TRAFFIC / PARKING AT AIR FORCE BASE YSTERPLAAT 20 – 21 SEPTEMBER 2008

As a result of the recent high rainfall in the area the organisers of AAD 2008, in conjunction with the City of Cape Town Traffic Services and the SAPS, wish to provide the following information to visitors and motorists that will be attending the public air show on Saturday and Sunday, 20 – 21 September 2008.

A limited amount of vehicles will be allowed to enter the base as most of the parking area is still waterlogged.

The following suggestions to motorists and visitors will ease the traffic congestion.

- Make use of the parking facilities at Ratanga Junction where a regular shuttle service will be in operation to transport visitors to and from the base;
- Motorists are also advised to make use of the parking areas at neighbouring schools:
 - Tygerhof Primary School
 - Buren High School & Ysterplaat Junior
 - Ysterplaat Primary Schoolas well as Brooklyn Chest Hospital
- Parking areas are available behind the KFC outlet in Milnerton in Koeberg road;
- Motorists are advised to make use of public transport;
- Where possible motorists should avoid the following roads:
 - Koeberg road between Section street and Boundary road
 - M5 between N2 and N1
 - N1 between M5 and N7
- Use one vehicle to transport the family. Less vehicles, less traffic;
- Come early to ensure the best possible parking. The gates will open from 06:00 am;
- Pre-paid tickets at discounted prices are available from NSRI and Cape Tourism Offices.

The organisers wish to thank the public for their understanding and call upon their full co-operation in this regard.
